

Memorandum of Understanding between The Republic Public Prosecutor's Office and Victimology Society of Serbia

In order to improve the rights of victims, Republic Public Prosecutor's Office and Victimology Society of Serbia signed a Memorandum of Understanding, on Friday 20th February 2015. This memorandum defines mutual cooperation which was undertaken in order to improve the position of victims and witnesses in criminal proceedings, in accordance with the law, international standards and best practice models. The Republic Public Prosecutor's Office and Victimology Society of Serbia will cooperate through the development of the „Victim's and witnesses support service“. The memorandum was signed by the Republic Public Prosecutor Zagorka Dolovac and president of the Victimology Society of Serbia Slobodan Savic, PhD. In addition to the signatories, the audience was addressed by His Excellency the British Ambassador Denis Keefe.
