The first part of the accredited training of social service providers for working with victims of gender-based violence was held



On October 10 and 11, 2023, the Victimology Society of Serbia held the first part of the accredited training for social service providers to work with victims of gender-based violence at the Palace Hotel in Belgrade. The second part of this training will be held on October, 17 and 18, 2023.

The planned four-day training is organized within the framework of the project entitled Let the victims remain winners: inform, empower, support!, which is implemented by the Victimology Society of Serbia-VDS, and financed by the Secretariat for Social Protection - City Administration of the City of Belgrade.

The training was attended by experts from the City Center for Social Work in Belgrade - from the departments of Novi Beograd, Palilula, Zemun, Surčin; Center for the Care of the Elderly, Children and Persons

with Disabilities "Novi Beograd"; Citizens association "Zvezda Center" as well as representatives of the City Municipality of New Belgrade.

The goal of the training is to provide basic knowledge for working with victims in an appropriate manner, with a special emphasis on victims of domestic violence, sexual violence and human trafficking, as well as the acquisition of the necessary skills and knowledge that will enable the provision of appropriate assistance to potential and current victims of gender-based violence and victims in a broader social sense.





Special emphasis is placed on the views of experts on gender equality and gender-based violence, as well as on experiences and challenges in working with victims.
