Online presentation of the VDS Info and Victim Support Service: The Importance of Support and Prevention in Working with Victims



On the occasion of marking February 22nd - the European Day of Victims, the Victimology Society of Serbia (VDS) held an online presentation on March 14, 2024, introducing the VDS Info and Victim Support Service: The Importance of Support and Prevention in Working with Victims. The presentation aimed to acquaint and discuss with students, as future professionals, who will directly or indirectly come into contact with victims of various criminal offenses, about the prevention of victimization and providing adequate support to victims of different criminal offenses.

participated in the event. In addition to interested students, professors, department representatives at faculties, and representatives of various student organizations also attended the presentation.

During the presentation, participants were introduced to the work of the VDS Info and Victim Support Service, which operates within the Victimology Society of Serbia and celebrated its two decades of existence last year. Additionally, participants were informed about the petition to declare May 3rd as a day of remembrance for victims of mass killings, initiated by the Victimology Society of Serbia.
